Thank you for those of you that have volunteered to help at the festival. We need more help!!!

Here is what is coming up:

Millennium High School Winter Drum Line Festival – I sent an email out last week concerning this event. I am attaching the list of people that have signed up for jobs and am asking for more help. As you can see we need a lot more people to make the event a success. Please send me an email of when you can work. This tends to be a \$4000-5000 money maker in a short 8 hour span. There are two shifts, shift 1 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM and shift 2 12:00-4:00 PM. We will do set up on Friday afternoon/night. The times will need to be decided and I will send you an additional email. Students were also asked to bring the following. Here is another description on the jobs.

- 1. Check-In Check in all units and controls the flow of the show
- 2. **Nurse** Be available for all first aid issues. We will deal with all serious issues via EMT
- 3. **Set up** Set up for the show on Friday night. Put tables, trash cans, trash bags, water jugs, concession equipment.
- 4. **Tickets** Sell tickets and keep number of people attending
- 5. **All Doors** Open and close the doors during the show. Do not let people in the gym during other performances. Watch for no food or drink in the gym except water.
- 6. **Runners** Help Check in, fill in for hosts, concessions, and fill water jugs, etc.
- 7. **Parking Lot** Aid people in parking and using all spots during the day.

Concessions/ Hospitality - Help the concession stand. Cook, sell, popcorn, sno cones, etc. Make sure judges and directors room are stocked with goodies.

- 8. **Inspection** Inspect all equipment for problems in there poles and violations
- 9. **Aux Gym** Help make sure people are in the auxiliary gym on time and also leave the gym on time.
